

**Truman City Council Work Session
November 28, 2022**

A Truman City Council Work Session was held at the Municipal Building Council Chambers on the 28th day of November, 2022 at 3:00 p.m.

Present: Mayor Terry Bentele, Councilor Patty Truax, Councilor Brandon Mosloski, Councilor Jake Ebert, and Councilor Brian Nickerson.

The work session was called to order to review the 2023 proposed budget and levy, along with assigned equity and fund reserves.

The proposed 2023 city budget was reviewed to evaluate line items to ensure they reflect expected revenue and expenses. The budget includes revenue from the Northrop police agreement. A meeting will be scheduled to discuss the agreement with Northrop city officials. Minor adjustments were made to various items. It was decided to expense a portion of the clerk's salary to the ambulance fund to reflect the time spent on work for that department. A revised budget will be reviewed at the December 5th meeting.
